The International English Language Testing System (IELTS) is the world's most popular English language proficiency test for higher education and global migration, with millions of IELTS tests taken each year.

About IELTS

IELTS is a test that measures the language proficiency of those who want to study or work in environments where English is used as a language of communication. There are two modules to choose from: **IELTS Academic and IELTS General Training.**

IELTS Academic

- To study at the undergraduate or postgraduate level.
- To join a professional organisation or registration in an English speaking country.

IELTS General Training

- To work or undertake work related training in an English speaking country.
- To immigrate to an English speaking country.
- To study or train at below degree level.


Each organisation sets its own entry requirements. In some cases, both the Academic and General Training module may be accepted. If you are in doubt as to which module to take, you should contact the organisation to which you are applying to confirm their requirements.





The IELTS Score scale

You will be given a score from 1 to 9 for each part of the test: Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking. The average of these four represents your overall band score. You can score whole (e.g. 5.0, 6.0, 7.0) or half (e.g. 5.5, 6.5, 7.5) bands in each part of the test.



The IELTS test format

The actual test taken is the same for both IELTS and IELTS for UKVI, with the same content, examiners, format, level of difficulty, scoring and so on. The only difference between the two is that IELTS for UKVI is administered in a test venue with video recording and CCTV facilities.

Speaking

(Time: 11 - 14 minutes)

A face-to-face interview comprised of three sections: short questions, speaking at length about a familiar topic and a structured discussion.

The Speaking test in IELTS on Computer is scheduled in the same day as your written test. It may be taken in the morning or in the afternoon and may either be delivered inperson or through video call.

Reading

(Time: 60 minutes)

Academic

There are three long reading passages with tasks. Texts range from descriptive and factual to the discursive and analytical and may include non - verbal material such as diagrams, graphs or illustrations.

General Training

There are three reading passages with tasks. Section 1 contains two or three short factual texts. Section 2 contains two short, work - related, factual texts. Section 3 contains one longer text on a topic of general interest.

Listening

(Time: 30 minutes, plus 10 minute extra to transfer your answer to the sheet in IELTS on paper)



There are four sections, which include both monologues and conversations. A variety of voices and accents are used and each section is played only once.

Writing

(Time: 60 minutes)



Academic

There are two tasks in total. In Task 1, you are presented with a table, graph, chart or diagram and are asked to describe, summarise or explain the information in no less than 150 words. In Task 2, you are asked to write an essay of no less than 250 words in response to a point of view, argument or problem.

General Training

There are two tasks. In Task 1, you are presented with a situation and are asked to write a letter of at least 150 words to request information or explain the situation. In Task 2, you are asked to write an essay of no less than 250 words in response to a point of view, argument or problem.

What is IELTS on Computer?

IELTS Life Skills

IELTS Life Skills is for people bound for the UK who need to show that athey have speaking and listening skills at Level A1, A2 or B1 of the Common European Framework (CEFR) of Reference for Languages.



This test is for those who need to prove their English speaking and listening skills as part of their application to UK Visas and Immigration for the Family of a Settled Person visa.


This test is for those who need to prove their speaking and listening skills as part of their application to UK Visas and Immigration for an extension to a Family, Spouse or Partner visa.





This test is for those who need to prove their speaking and listening skills as part of their application to UK Visas and Immigration for an extension to a Family, Spouse or Partner visa.





IELTS Life Skills is a speaking and listening test. You will take the test face - to - face with an examiner, along with one other candidate. You will participate in a structured conversation listening and responding to a selection of tasks.

The tasks in IELTS Life Skills are designed to reflect the everyday experience of communicating in an English - speaking country. You will be expected to take part in short discussions on everyday subjects.



Speaking and Listening (Time: 16-18 minutes)

You will be expected to: Listen and respond to spoken language, including simple narratives, statements, questions and single - step instructions.

Communicate basic information, feelings and opinions on familiar topics.

Talk with another person in a familiar situation about familiar topics.

A2

Speaking and Listening (Time: 20 minutes)

You will be expected to:

Listen and respond to spoken language, including straightforward information, short narratives, explanations and instructions.

Communicate information, feelings and opinions on familiar topics.

Talk with one or more people in a familiar situation to establish a shared understanding about familiar topics.

B1

Speaking and Listening

(Time: 22 minutes)

You will be expected to:

Listen and respond to spoken language, including straightforward information and narratives, and follow straightforward explanations and instructions.

Communicate information, feelings and opinions on familiar topics using appropriate formality. Talk with one or more people in a familiar situation, making relevant points and responding to what others say to reach a shared understanding about familiar topics.

STEP 01

Choose how to take your IELTS test and book online

You can take your test at one of our official test centres on paper or on computer. All you need is a valid identification document and your bank card should you want to pay online.





Book your test

Choose from either IELTS on paper, IELTS on computer, or IELTS for UKVI. You may view the test dates and locations here: www.britishcouncil.ph/exam/ielts/dates-fees-locations





Keep your valid ID onhand

Valid ID can be in a form of a passport, GSIS/SSS ID, PRC License or UMID. Make sure to have your valid ID ready as you will need to enter your ID number or upload a clear photocopy of it when you book your test.

*Note: Candidates under 18 years of age have to supply written consent by a parent or guardian in order to apply for a test place.



Make a payment for the test

Pay for your test through any of the options below.

- Credit card
- BDO Bills Payment over the counter at any BDO branch
- BDO Bills Payment via BDO App or Personal/Business Online Banking
- Bank Transfer from non-BDO account

*Note: You have 24 hours to complete your registration and payment otherwise your registration will be automatically cancelled.



Wait for your confirmation

Upon registration and successful payment, you will receive an e-mail confirming that your place has been reserved. Three working days before the test day, you will receive a reminder e-mail about the test. You can also view and print the information on our online registration system.









IELTS Test Results

Test results will be available 13 calendar days (IELTS on paper) or three to five days (IELTS on computer) after the written test, excluding public holidays. You can view your results online through the <u>Test Taker Portal</u>.

Your IELTS result is valid for two years. Official results are given on a Test Report Form (TRF). Your TRF will either be mailed to you or made available for self-collection at the British Council office. For TRF sent by mail, it may take an additional three to five working days. Please ensure that you provide a valid correspondence address on the application form.

Extra Test Report Form (TRF)

You are given only ONE copy of the Test Report Form (TRF). As part of our service, British Council can send additional copies on your behalf to institutions via courier upon submission of a request form and payment of applicable courier fee. The courier fees are PHP 1,400 for international address and PHP 250 for local embassies.

*Only IELTS recognising organisations subscribed to the electronic download service can download test taker's results.

Enquiry on Result (EOR) Service

Test takers may apply for an enquiry on results (EOR) only at the centre at which they took the test and within six weeks of the test date. For a fee of PHP 5, 250 (IELTS) / PHP 7,100 (IELTS for UKVI) / PHP 5,300 (Life Skills), the test taker's material is forwarded to the UK for re-marking. If the score on any module increases after re-marking, the fee will be refunded. The result will normally be available in 21 days, depending on several factors including the number of sections requested for remark. If you have not received a response after 28 days, please contact your test centre.

Health and Safety Protocols for COVID-19



COVID-19 Test Day Requirements

If you are taking the test in a venue other than The Curve in BGC, we require that you present one of the following on your test day:

- 1. Proof of full vaccination (actual vaccination card or certificate). A person is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after their last dose.
- 2. Paper proof (hard copy) of a negative Covid-19 antigen test a day before the first test component.
- 3. Paper proof (hard copy) of a negative RT-PCR test taken up to 72 hours before the first exam component.
- 4. If you have recently recovered from Covid-19, paper proof (hard copy) of full recovery from your healthcare professional that you have been cleared of Covid-19 within six months before your test date.

All candidates taking the test at The Curve in BGC will have to provide proof of full vaccination, in line with the building's policy.

Other health and safety measures on test days

Self-declaration form

All test takers must sign a declaration form at the entrance of the exams area on test day to declare that they are eligible to attend the test session.

Please do not attend your test if:

- You are under a 14-day compulsory quarantine, stay-at-home order, medical surveillance or a self-quarantine order, as specified by the Philippine Government
- You have a high temperature, persistent cough, difficulty breathing or other flu-like symptoms.
- You have had close contact with confirmed Covid-19 case, or someone displaying Covid-19 symptoms

Under 18s

Test takers under 18 years of age are strongly recommended to be accompanied by an adult until the necessary checks at the entrance of the test venue have been completed. If you are then excluded from the test, you and your accompanying adult must leave immediately.

If you have not been given permission to leave the test venue unaccompanied, you will be escorted to a holding area until an adult comes to pick you up. Our staff will follow the British Council child protection policy and procedures when they proceed with this arrangement.

This requirement is for the health and safety of all test-takers – if you are unable to comply with this at this point, we apologise – you may request a transfer or refund.

- We are implementing temperature screening in the test venue before test takers enter the exams area. Test takers with symptoms of fever will not be able to take the test
- We advise you to report an additional 30 minutes prior to the previously specified arrival time of the test
- Please follow basic hygiene practices such as using hand-sanitiser provided on test day and regularly washing your hands
- Please maintain a one metre distance from other test takers or staff wherever possible
- Please bring your face mask that covers your mouth and nose and a full face shield. You may be requested to remove this for identification or other purposes.
- For speaking tests staff and examiners may/will also wear a face mask. Neither the test taker nor the examiner can insist that the other remove or put on a mask for the purpose of the interview
- All test venues will be thoroughly cleaned prior to the start of the test. For computer delivered tests, equipment will be cleaned between sessions
- You will be asked to take any stationery you use at the venue away with you except scratch paper, notes or workings sheets.

After your test:

If you are diagnosed with Covid-19 within 14 days after you take your test, please report this to your test centre by email. This will help ensure we can communicate with other test takers and follow local health authority and government advice.
