The system is accessible to a broad range of customers including the unemployed, the underemployed, displaced workers, new entrants to the labor force, technical vocational institutions and enterprise-based training providers

The quality of training delivery is premised on the Unified TVET program Registration and Accreditation System (UTPRAS),.

The system of competency based Philippine TVET Qualifications and Certification System (PTQCS) is the basis of national credentials issued for TVET,


The system recognizes prior competencies acquired through various alternative means.

Employment and productivity enhancement are the ultimate metrics of the technical vocational education and training system.


TESDA builds up the TVET sector capability and capacity.
